TINKER LANE PRIVACY POLICY

Introduction

This website domain is <https://tinkerlane.co.uk> and the web site content held on that domain is hereafter referred to as ("Tinker Lane" Website) respects your privacy and is committed to protecting it through compliance with this website privacy policy ("Policy").

Maintaining protection of the information entrusted to our care by our members is of the utmost importance to "Tinker Lane" Website .

This "Policy" describes the types of information that you may provide when you visit "Tinker Lane" Website, and our practices for collecting, using, protecting and disclosing that information.

This "Policy" applies to information we collect:

- On "Tinker Lane" Website.
- In e-mail, text and other electronic messages between you and "Tinker Lane" Website.
- When you interact with us in another way - for example, contacting us with an inquiry.

This "Policy" outlines our policies and practices regarding your personal information (information relating to you from which you can be identified) and how we will treat it. This "Policy" may change from time to time (see *Changes to our Privacy Policy* section below), so please check the "Policy" periodically for updates.

Information We Collect About You and How We Collect It

We collect several types of information from and about users of "Tinker Lane" Website, including information:

- by which you may be personally identified, your name, your e-mail address or telephone number ("Personal Data") but only if you provide it on our "CONTACT US" page or otherwise provide it to us.

We collect this information:

- From the "CONTACT US" page automatically if you provide it to us. By email if you communicate directly or by face to face communication.

Information You Provide to Us

We collect information you provide on our "CONTACT US" page when you interact with "Tinker Lane" Website:

- Records and copies of your correspondence (including e-mail and other electronic messages, including social media posts).

You may provide information or articles or give us consent to use photo images to be published or displayed (hereinafter, "posted") on public areas of "Tinker Lane" Website defined as ""User Content"). Your ""User Content"" is ""posted"" on and transmitted to others at your own risk. Additionally, we cannot control the actions of other users of "Tinker Lane" Website with whom you may choose to share your ""User Content"". We only publish 'User Content' with your permission and do not normally identify individuals in a photo. The only exception to us naming individuals in photos is if you have given permission for this. We credit the owner of the photo by name or as agreed with the owner.

Usage Details, IP Addresses, Cookies and Other Technologies

We do not collect information as you navigate through and interact with "Tinker Lane" Website:

- We do not use cookies (or browser cookies) "Tinker Lane" Website on . A cookie is a small file placed on the hard drive of your computer. You may in any event refuse to accept browser cookies by activating the appropriate setting on your browser.
- You should be aware that there may be cookies employed indirectly if there is embedded content and you choose to view it as described in 'Embedded content from other websites' below.

We do not collect personal information automatically.

How We Use Your Information

We use information that we collect from our website "CONTACT US" or items that are posted by us with your consent or that you provide to us, to contact you and to follow up actions on your behalf. We may also use that information:

- To provide you with information that you request from us.
- To comply with any legal obligation
- For any other purpose where we have your consent.

Automated newsletters

When a new post is created on "Tinker Lane" Website, and you have signed up to receive posts, an email containing a link to the post is sent to your email address; these are known as Automated Newsletters.

Automated newsletters are provided by the [MailPoet](#) feature from within the . "Tinker Lane" Website. Registration for this service requires an email address only which is stored within the automated newsletter database to enable the feature.

You can unsubscribe at any time from this service by clicking on the Unsubscribe link shown on all newsletters. Alternatively you may request to be unsubscribed through "CONTACT US".

Users who have unsubscribed from this service will have their email address permanently deleted from our systems and databases within 30 days.

Embedded content from other websites

Articles on "Tinker Lane" Website may include embedded content (e.g. videos, images, articles, etc.). Embedded content from other websites behaves in the exact same way as if the visitor has visited the other website.

These websites may collect data about you, use cookies, embed additional third-party tracking, and monitor your interaction with that embedded content, including tracing your interaction with the embedded content if you have an account and are logged in to that website.

Disclosure of Your Information

- We may disclose "Personal Data" to comply with any court order, law or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request.

Donor Privacy Information

"Tinker Lane" Website will not sell, trade or share donor names, phone numbers, emails. "User Content" posted on the website may however be shared on social media by readers.

Accessing and Correcting Your Information

You may contact us through "CONTACT US" to request access to, correct or delete any personal information that you have provided to us. We may not accommodate a request to change information if we believe the change would violate any law or legal requirement or cause the information to be incorrect.

If we delete your "User Content" from "Tinker Lane" Website, copies of your "User Content" may remain viewable in cached and archived pages, or might have been copied or stored by other Website users.

Children Under the Age of 16

"Tinker Lane" Website is not intended for children under 16 years of age. No one under age 16 may provide any personal information to or on "Tinker Lane" Website. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 16. If you are under 16, do not use or provide any information on our Website. If we learn we have collected or received personal information from a child under 16 without verification of parental consent, we will delete that information. If you believe we might have any information from or about a child under 16, please inform us using "CONTACT US".

Data Security

We have implemented technical and operational measures designed to secure your personal information from accidental loss and from unauthorised access, use, alteration and disclosure. All personal information you provide to us is stored on a password-protected computer.

We urge you to be careful about giving out personal information in public areas of "Tinker Lane" Website. The information you share in public areas may be viewed by any user of "Tinker Lane" Website.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although we do our best to protect your personal information, we cannot guarantee the security of your

personal information transmitted to "Tinker Lane" Website or over any public network. Any transmission of personal information is at your own risk. Without prejudice to any mandatory legal obligations to which we may be subject, we are not responsible for circumvention of any privacy settings or security measures contained on "Tinker Lane" Website.

Changes to Our Privacy "Policy"

"Tinker Lane" Website privacy "Policy" may change, be added to, be modified or portions removed from this "Policy" at any time, which shall become effective immediately upon posting on this page. The date the "Policy" was last revised is identified at the bottom of the page. It is your responsibility to review this "Policy" for any changes. By continuing to use "Tinker Lane" Website, you agree to any changes in the "Policy".

EU Privacy Notice

If you are a resident of the European Union (EU) or European Economic Area (EEA) whose personal information we collect, the following additional information applies to you.

1 Introduction

1.1 - Where you are an EU or EEA resident and "Tinker Lane" Website knowingly collects your personal information (also called "Personal Data"), we will do so in accordance with applicable laws that regulate data protection and privacy. This includes, without limitation, the EU General Data Protection Regulation (2016/679) ('GDPR') and EU member state national laws that implement or regulate the collection, processing and privacy of your "Personal Data" (together, 'EU Data Protection Law').

1.2 - This EU privacy notice ('EU Privacy Notice') which should be read in conjunction with "Tinker Lane" Website Privacy "Policy" provides further information as required under EU Data Protection Law on how we handle or process the "Personal Data" we collect and who we may share it with.

1.3 - This Privacy Notice also provides information on your legal rights under EU Data Protection Law and how you can exercise them.

2 The lawful grounds on which we collect and process "Personal Data"

2.1 - We process your "Personal Data" for the above purposes, relying on one or more of the following lawful grounds under EU Data Protection Law:

(a) where you have freely provided your specific, informed and unambiguous consent for "Tinker Lane" Website to process your "Personal Data" for particular purposes:

(d) where we need to comply with a legal obligation or for the purpose of us being able to establish, exercise or defend legal claims.

5 Disclosing your "Personal Data" to third parties

5.3 - We will treat your "Personal Data" as private and will not routinely disclose it to third party without you knowing about it. The exceptions are in relation to legal proceedings or where we are legally required to do so and cannot tell you (such as a criminal investigation). We always aim to ensure that your "Personal Data" is only used by third parties we deal with for lawful purposes and who observe the principles of EU Data Protection Law.

6 How long we retain your "Personal Data"

6.1 - "Tinker Lane" Website has adopted a data retention "Policy" for EU residents (which we may make available on request) that sets out the different periods we may retain "Personal Data" for in respect of relevant purposes in accordance with our duties under EU Data Protection Law. The criteria we use for determining the relevant retention and disposal periods we adopt are based on the purpose for which we hold data and the reasonable expectations of those whose "Personal Data" we collect in these circumstances, taking into account various legislative requirements and guidance issued by relevant EU regulatory authorities.

6.2 - In accordance with the above retention "Policy", the "Personal Data" that we no longer need will be disposed of and/or anonymised so you can no longer be identified from it.

7 Your "Personal Data" rights

7.1 - In accordance with your legal rights under EU Data Protection Law, you have a 'subject access request' right under which can request information about the "Personal Data" that we hold about you, what we use that "Personal Data" for and who it may be disclosed to as well as certain other information.

7.2 - Usually we will have one month to respond to a subject access request. However, we reserve the right to verify your identity and we may, in case of complex requests, require a further two months to respond. We may also charge for administrative time in dealing with any manifestly unreasonable or excessive requests. We may also require further information to locate the specific information you seek and certain legal exemptions under EU Data Protection Law may apply when responding to your subject access request.

7.3 - Under EU Data Protection Law. EU/EEA residents also have the following rights. which are exercisable by making a request to us in writing:

(a) that we correct "Personal Data" that we hold about you which is inaccurate or incomplete:

(b) that we erase your "Personal Data" without undue delay if we no longer need to hold or process it:

(c) to object to any automated processing (where applicable) that we carry out in relation to your "Personal Data". for example if we conduct any automated credit scoring:

(d) to object to our use of your "Personal Data" for direct marketing:

(e) to object and/or to restrict the use of your "Personal Data" for purpose other than those set out above unless we have a compelling legitimate reason: or

(f) that we transfer "Personal Data" to another party where the "Personal Data" has been collected with your consent or is being used to perform contract with you and is being processed by automated means.

7.4 - If you would like to exercise any of the rights set out above, please contact us using "CONTACT US"

7.5 - If you make a request and are not satisfied with our response, or believe that we are illegally processing your "Personal Data", you have the right to complain to the Office of the Information Commissioner in the United Kingdom.
